KARIN SPALTER

This issue of RADIO NEWS went to press two days after the death on 28th January of *Karin Spalter* award-winning broadcaster, producer and director and wife of *Tony Currie*. Karin had little choice but to be involved in Radio Six for her entire married life, but bore the burden stoically and delighted listeners with periodic gems like her music series **Aroundabathtime**, poetry programme **Verse and Worse** and the perennial **Midwinter Echoes**. She supported Tony in every possible way (except when she thought he was doing something daft) and contributed to the station in so many ways. She will be hugely missed by her friends and family. She was a helluva woman.

Karin began her broadcasting career as host of **News and Lookaround** on Border Television, whilst simultaneously acting in radio plays on the BBC Home Service. She moved to Scottish Television as a Production Assistant, then Radio Clyde as its sole features producer, working on seven programmes a week including producing the Saturday afternoon sports programme and her own celebrity chat show **Social and Personal**.

We'll celebrate her life on February 12th with an afternoon of some of her programmes – chat shows, poetry and music.
