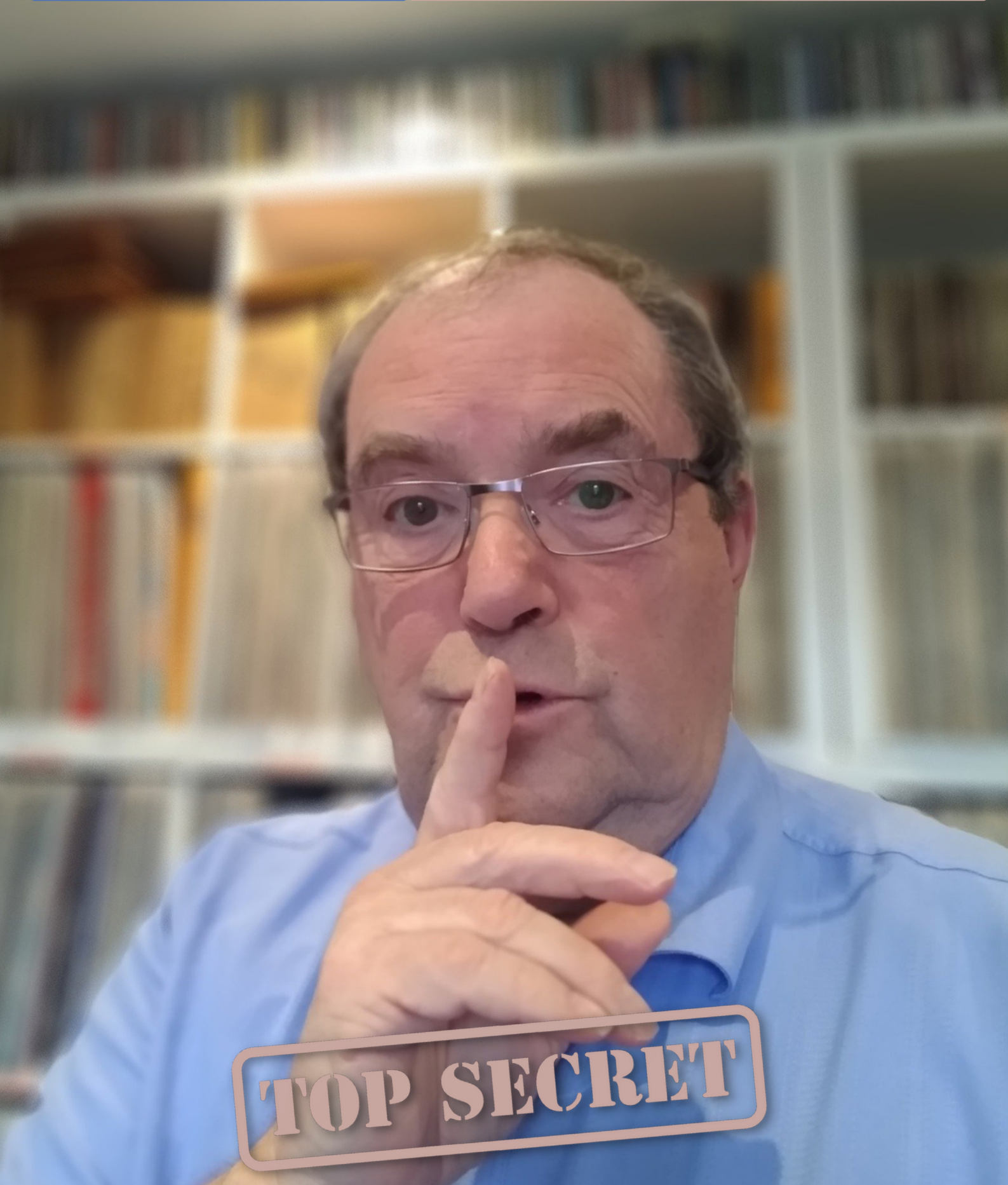

What's Tony Currie's big secret? Well, just when I was half expecting to have to say that there was nothing new to report, along comes plenty news. **SECOND HAND SONGS** comes to its conclusion on October 14th after 100 shows. Al Galpin has done a terrific job, and we will miss his extraordinary knowledge of the subject. **But** replacing him in the 21:00 Saturday slot is Tony Currie with **OFF THE SHELF**, a programme devoted to the unusual, rare, unexpected and downright bizarre items in the dark and dusty corners of the Radio Six International record library. Not just music. Expect the unexpected!

There's a special Lively Lounge programme featuring the late **PETE SMITH**, a deft and colourful arranger and a man whose music has featured very prominently on the station since 1968. After his death on September 15th, there was a **LIVELY LOUNGE** programme featuring some of his music, but this special on October 1st at 14:00 GMT is all his music plus his own comments.

Overdue a rerun is **RADIO RICHARD** featuring musical polyglot Richard Niles talking to a range of his favourite musicians, including Michael MacDonald, Lyle Mays, Michael Brecker, Nile Rodgers, Richard Carpenter, John Allman, Barry Manilow and Gary Silese. Find him on Tuesdays at 19:00 from Oct 10th.

Glen Dickson carries on with his three **WRITERS BLOCK RADIO HOUR** shows (now getting a New Zealand repeat at 06:00 on Wednesdays) and there are rumours of more new dramas to come in November, as well as an exciting new music series from our old pal Spike Nesmith - and his son!

Hallowe'en is a time when we have always pulled out the stops for spookiness. For the last couple of years we've had repeats of older shows but this year it's a brand new special with Tony Currie on Tuesday 31st at 19:00. UK clocks go back on the 29th so that means it can be heard at 7pm.
